
Invesco Sh Dur Inflation Protected Fund (A)

The Fund seeks to provide protection from the negative effects of unanticipated inflation. The Fund invests in the component securities of the ICE BofA 1-5 Year US Inflation-Linked Treasury Index and in derivatives and other instruments that have economic characteristics similar to such securities. The index is comprised of U.S. Treasury Inflation Protected Securities with at least \$1 billion in outstanding face value and a remaining term to final maturity of at least 1 year and less than 5 years at the time of index rebalancing.
